**WHEREAS**, in 2002 and in 2006 said agreement was renewed.

**WHEREAS**, County of Dodge intends to continue participating with other political subdivisions to provide an Enhanced 911 Program with the understanding that all applicable costs be funded through a telephone user charge.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Dodge County Board of Supervisors that they approve the attached INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT for a period of ten years acknowledging a name change of the administrating body now known as the Fremont/Dodge County PSAP Governance Board.

Dear County Board,

The Dodge County Emergency Telephone Authority, commonly referred to as Dodge County E-911, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Statutes, Chap. 13, Article 8, enacted Inter-Local agreements for the purpose of establishing an enhanced 911 system in 1992. This Inter-Local agreement has been renewed in 2002 and again in 2006, when the surcharge was changed. Those 2006 agreements were for 10 years and are now due for renewal. The Inter-Local agreements were enacted for the purpose of establishing an enhanced 911 system for the benefit of emergency communications for the residents of Dodge County and other areas served by Dodge County emergency services such as fire and rescue.

Enclosed is a copy of the new Inter-Local agreement for the next 10 year period. The new agreement is the same as the current agreement, with the exception of a name change of the administrating body. With the consolidation of the Dodge County and Fremont public safety answering points, the original Dodge County Emergency Telephone Authority became the Fremont/Dodge County PSAP Governance Board.

Please review the Inter-Local agreement, enact a resolution supporting the agreement and return one copy of the Inter-Local agreement signed and dated by an authorized member of your Board or Council. Please attach a copy of the resolution to the agreement. The second copy of the Agreement is for your records.

Should your Board or Council have any questions concerning the above matter, feel free to contact any of the below Governance Board members or myself.

Please try to have the Agreement and resolutions signed and sent back to me at the below address as soon as possible. The new Inter-Local Agreement will go in to effect January 1, 2017 and expire December 31, 2026.

INTERLOCAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT  
ENHANCED (E-911) EMERGENCY TELEPHONE SERVICE

Pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat., Chap. 13, Art. 8, the Inter-Local Cooperation Agreement hereafter referred to as the Agreement, is entered into by, between, and among the County of Dodge, the County of Burt, the County of Saunders, the County of Colfax, the County of Cuming, the County of Washington, the City of Dodge, the City of Snyder, the City of Scribner, the City of Hooper, the City of Uehling, the City of Winslow, the City of Nickerson, the City of North Bend, the Village of Inglewood, the City of Fremont and all political subdivisions of the State of Nebraska and hereafter referred to as the Parties, the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January, 2017.

1. Duration

This agreement shall continue for a period of ten years

2. Separate Legal or Administrative Entity; Delegation

There shall be no separate legal or administrative entity created by this Inter-Local Cooperation Agreement. Administration of this agreement is delegated to the Fremont/Dodge County PSAP Governance Board, hereafter referred to as the Board.

3. Purpose

The purpose of this Agreement is to provide for a 911 emergency telephone communications system for the territory consisting of the telephone exchange boundaries of North Bend, Dodge Snyder, Scribner, Hooper, Winslow, Nickerson, Fremont, Inglewood and Uehling, all of which are located within the jurisdictional boundaries of the parties hereto.

4. Manner of financing and Maintaining a budget

Each party shall adopt and impose one dollar (\$1.00) per line per month surcharge upon all telephone lines within each party's jurisdiction, pursuant to LB 240, 1990 Legislature. The Fremont/Dodge County PSAP Governance Board shall administer

said 911 emergency telephone communications systems; shall establish and maintain a budget therefor; shall establish and maintain rules and regulations for the operation thereof; and shall acquire, hold and dispose of real and personal property used in this undertaking solely in its name.

5. Termination

This Agreement shall remain in effect and be in force until December 31, 2026. Termination prior to that time shall require the mutual consent of all parties.

6. Administer

The chairman of the Board is hereby appointed administrator for this cooperative undertaking.

7. Manner of Disposing Property

It is understood and agreed that all property will be acquired in the name of Fremont/Dodge County Communication Center. Property shall be disposed of in accordance with the laws and rules applicable to said authority. Proceeds of any such disposal shall be and remain in the property of Fremont/Dodge County Communication Center.

8. Each party agrees to adopt this agreement by resolution and shall file the same with Board in Fremont, Nebraska.
