To the Dodge County Board of Supervisors,

I am writing as the president of the North Bend Area Chamber of Commerce to request permission to temporarily close a portion of County Road 8, aka "Cemetery Road," on the northeast edge of North Bend on June 26, 2021, for the Old Settlers fireworks show.

The section we wish to close would begin just north of the intersection of Road 8 and 11th Street in North Bend and extent north about a half mile. The Diffey and Roubal homes on Road 8, as well as the cemetery, would still be accessible from the north during the closure. Our north barricade would be just south of Diffey's lane.

The reason is that the fireworks show will be shot from Cemetery Road (Road 8) and we need to block off the possible fallout area. The closure would be from 4 p.m. to after the show, about 10:30 p.m., on Saturday, June 26.

We have the support and permission of North Bend Fire Chief Waylon Fischer.
